October is going to be a great month, with Melbourne saxophonist Julian Wilson sure to pull a big crowd and clarinet / sax virtuoso Adrian Cunningham releasing his new CD.

Lots of local favourites too, like David Bentley, Shannon Marshall, Caxton Street and Peter Walters all making welcome returns to the club. Pugsley Buzzard is bound to put on a great show and will no doubt showcase material from his new CD Wooden Kimono. Don't forget that Jazz Singers Jam Night has now moved to Thursday nights.
